**Animal Handling Waiver, National Animal Health Declaration, National Vendor Declaration and Entry forms including membership and entry fees to the convenors before 1st October**

All animals to be judged as interbreed and must be registered in an appropriate Stud Book in accordance with the appropriate breed society regulations. The minimum status requirement is **J-BAS score of 6**. Please list J-BAS Scores and P.I.C. on entry form. All ages to be taken from 1st of October 2019.

## **Conditions of Entry:**

1. Cattle will be required to be tested for Pestivirus and certified as non-PI (persistently infected)
2. Exhibitors must complete section 3b on the National Cattle Health Declaration stating this testing complete. Copies of test results must be submitted with entry forms.
3. Cattle judging commences as per program.
4. All exhibitors must be member of the Clare A&H Society Inc.
5. All cattle to be led in the ring
6. All bulls over one year must have nose ring
7. All cattle must have nose clips when being led, excluding Calf at foot.
8. Cattle Trucks use Northern Stock Gate entrance before 7:00am.
9. Animal Handling waivers must be signed by all exhibitors
