Exhibits to be mounted on cardboard mounts (coloured) if more than one item in the class. Not to be covered with plastic. If, in the opinion of Steward or Judge, an exhibit has previously taken a prize, it shall be removed from judging without notifying the exhibitor.

Prizes not awarded to articles that are not of a suitable standard. Prize money to be collected from the Secretary's Office after 3.00pm. Exhibits are to be collected after 5.00pm.
